Grade Level: K/1

Type of Lesson: Singing Game

Title: Sally Go Round the Sun

Description: Sally Go Round the Sun is a well-known folk tune with many variations of the melody as well as the game. I'm sharing the version I sing in my classroom. Students stand in a circle formation holding hands. Select one student to stand in the center of the circle. Students walk counterclockwise as the song is sung. At the end of the song, students say "Ka-boom!" On the "Ka" – students release their hands. On the "boom," students sit on the floor. Chant (extension) "Don't cry Sally, don't cry Sally! Wipe those tears away! Don't cry Sally, don't cry Sally! Jump up now and play!"
