Type of Lesson: Instrument

Title: Who Are You?

Description: Students walk to the right with their left hands in the middle. (16 beats)“...where we ought to be...” clap and turn around with a right hand in the middle. Walk to the left (8 beats) and clap/stop on the word “right.”Twill be in the valley of love and delight.” Two slow bows. (8 beats)Quick, small hands wave to the beat. (8 beats)Big two-beat motions up and down. (8 beats) Turn in a circle to the right for 8 beats (clap on 7). Turn in a circle to the left for 8 beats (clap on 7). Then, make the moves with the parachute. If they can handle it, then I add small items such as bean bags, stuffed animals, or scarves onto the parachute.

Curriculum Connection: Keeping track of and organization of beats. (Math).

Literacy Connection: Students can bring a pen and paper to help keep track of beats and read music. (Music and English).
